Passion to Talk, Talk to Inspire





“Eco-friendly “Donating Dreams” for Children:
Lunar New Year Fundraising Fair”

With the Lunar New Year approaching, the inter-school international student aid organization "Dream Compassioners" will host the "Dream Carnival" Lunar New Year charity fair from February 11 to 17, 2026, at Booth 204 in Victoria Park, Causeway Bay. In addition to selling a variety of creative products, the organization has launched the "Donate Dreams: Plush Toy Recruitment" program to collect well-maintained plush toys. All proceeds from the sale, combined with other earnings, will be donated to institutions in need, such as the "Motherland Cambodia Education Center (MLC)," to bring warmth to local children.

“ The "Donate Dreams" Program: Eco-friendly Initiative to Give Idle Toys New Life ”



Since 2021, "Dream Compassioners" has spearheaded the "Donate Dreams" resources donation project, regularly collecting clothing, stationery, and other supplies to be redistributed to children in need in Laos, Nepal, and Cambodia. This year, the Dream Compassioners service team from Yan Chai Hospital Law Chan Chor Si College took the lead in the project, promoting environmental sustainability and global citizenship by giving idle items a "second life". As team leader Tang Wing Lam shared: "The donated supplies filled plastic bins one by one—every small contribution adds up. Being able to put these items to good use and bring warmth to children's homes in need is truly moving." The team has further expanded the project this year by selecting specific plush toys to be sold alongside other products, with all profits benefiting students in need worldwide. More school service teams and supporting schools are expected to join soon, all with the hopes to make a contribution.



“ Handcrafted by Students: Designs Filled with Love ”

The products at the Lunar New Year Fair carry significant meaning. Some items are handcrafted by children living in homes in Cambodia and Zambia, while others are designed by the student organizing committee. Featured products include unique "Trendy Slang Signboard Keychains", practical "Warmth Calendars", fun "MBTI Mahjong Blind Boxes", and "Slang Poker". Through these meticulous designs, the students hope to raise maximum funds to support children in need.

“ Emergency Aid for Cambodian Children’s Homes: ” Long-term Goal to Build Classrooms

One of the main beneficiaries, the "Motherland Cambodia Education Center (MLC)," was founded by Sibyl, a Hong Kong native, and her Cambodian husband, Dara. The center is dedicated to providing free education for "left-behind" children in remote areas. Thanks to funding from the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau, the team visited MLC last year for volunteer teaching and witnessed their urgent needs firsthand. Pang Nam Sai, a student at the University of Hong Kong and one of the core organizing committee members of the fair noted: "During our volunteer teaching in Cambodia, I felt the children's needs and saw their hardwork. Beyond being moved, I want to take action through this fair to contribute to their dreams of education." Another Vice Chairperson, Tam Hoi Lam from the Chinese University of Hong Kong, added: "The vitality and innocence of the Cambodian children deeply touched me. I hope to do my best to support them so their smiles can continue to bloom." Consequently, the funds raised this year aim to build safe and comfortable classrooms for the children to improve their future.



“ Sustained Care: ” Spreading Hong Kong’s Warmth

In the past year, the Dream Compassioners' Lunar New Year Charity Fair has successfully supported "New Future for Children" in Cambodia and the "Zango Foundation" in Zambia, improving local children's living conditions and educational facilities. The team hopes to continue gathering the compassion of Hong Kong citizens to spread warmth across the globe.
