### DEBATE COMPETITION (PRIMARY SESSION)



To raise public awareness of issues relating to children, poverty, and social concerns, Dream Compassioners launched the Dream Compassioners Debate Competition for Secondary Schools in 2021 as an advocacy initiative. The competition provides a platform for debaters to engage in intellectual exchange while promoting the spirit of service and global awareness. The competition has received strong support from the education sector and has been successfully held for five consecutive years. In the current year, the secondary school division attracted participation from ninety schools, making it one of the largest debating competitions in Hong Kong. In view of this, Dream Compassioners introduced a primary school division in the previous year, with the aim of encouraging students from different age groups to take part and further promoting the spirit of service. The primary school group has already begun recruitment this month. 

# “PASSION TO TALK, TALK TO INSPIRE”

In November, we were honored to invite Miss Jessica Liu, a representative of Love 21 Foundation, to be the guest speaker for the 36th regular "Passion to Talk, Talk to Inspire" themed "Down Syndrome and the Neurodiversity Community in Hong Kong". The speaker shared the founding and operation experience of the free service programs, and talked about how to build a diversified platform for the growth and social integration of people with down syndrome, autism and ADHD.

During the sharing, Jessica mentioned that Love 21 Foundation serves people with special needs aged 6 to 60, among whom 60% to 70% come from single-parent families. With the aspiration of "Exploring the Potential of Special Groups", the project has launched more than 90 types of activities including football, basketball, percussion music, lion dance and pickleball, offering over a thousand courses every month, as well as supporting service such as parent workshops. In addition to focusing on nurturing talents, the organization also places great importance on the mental health of its members.



To this end, the center has launched nutritionist programs, offering one-on-one consultations to help parents and children understand the importance of healthy eating, thereby preventing health risks caused by genetic issues.


Unlike service organizations that rely on government funding, Love 21 Foundation's funding comes from corporate sponsorships. Adhering to a completely free service model, it promotes the social integration of special groups with a self-sustaining operational approach.

In the face of society's misunderstandings about SEN communities, Jessica also encourages more people to actively participate in volunteer work. Through concrete actions, they can better understand and support these individuals, break existing prejudices, and help them overcome the challenges they face in daily life. 
