Read to inspire

Last month, we were honoured to have Ms. Clarisse Poon, the founder of Light Their Rights HK as the guest speaker for the 25th regular online talk of "Passion to Talk, Talk to Inspire". She shared her volunteer experience with us under the theme of "Childlike Heart, Synonymous with Love and Truth - Inheritance of the Spirit of Righteousness."

Ms. Poon has been passionate about doing volunteer work since childhood, visiting nursing homes and distributing supplies to the homeless. She later volunteered with different NGOs and gained experience in organising events through joining joint-school organisations. She eventually established the volunteer platform "Light Their Rights HK" to provide ongoing assistance to homeless individuals and young people.

Hence, Ms Poon stated her thoughts further by stating the challenges she faced in establishing Light Their Rights HK as a high school student, including identifying suitable beneficiaries, securing sponsors, conducting promotions, and recruiting volunteers. She advised us not to give up easily and bravely respond to challenges.

Lastly, Ms Poon advised seizing opportunities and gaining experience through volunteer services to prepare for establishing a charitable organisation. She emphasised the importance of making plans, understanding beneficiaries, and creating a unique path of service in life.

The service spirit of Lights Their Rights HK and Ms. Poon has helped numerous groups in society. Through youth workshops and services for the homeless, they have inspired and motivated many lives, deserving of praise and emulation!
