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## The 3rd Dream Compassioneers Inter-School Service Debate Competition



The 3rd Dream Compassioneers Inter-School Service Debate Competition was successfully held on August 19th for the semi-finals. The motion for this round is "Child labour do more good than harm in developing countries." All four semi-final teams had an in-depth discussion on the influence of child labor on children's health and on their families' living conditions. We hope that students can understand and reflect on the issue of children's right.

At the same time, we would like to thank all the cooperating schools, including Bishop Hall Jubilee School, Maryknoll Convent School (Secondary Section), Sacred Heart Canossian College and Good Hope School, for sending out staff members and judges. Last, We would like to express our gratitude to all the schools for their active support of the 3rd Dream Compassioneers Debate Competition and enthusiastic participation in the competition. The Grand Final of the competition will be held in October. More details will be announced soon. We hope that we can continue to enjoy the eloquent speeches of the debaters and promote the spirit of service through the debates.





## HKSSLA 2022

In this month, the finalists from Hong Kong Student Service Leaders Award have launched their fund-raising and service activities. They are expected to round up all activities in September.

Regarding the fundraising activities, the first group (Agapi) held a Cambodian bracelets workshop and collected registration fees on August 15 at the community center. During the workshop, they incorporated elements of Cambodia to help participants understand the cultural characteristics of Cambodia. They also participated in a market on August 5 and 6 to sell their products and hold mini workshops.

The second group of students (Fluoresco) raised funds through a charity sale. They have designed three products: a laptop bag, a shoulder bag, and an accessory bag, all printed with images related to Cambodia, including the Cambodian symbol and Khmer script. They sold the products at a physical market on August 12 and 13, while promoting their cause online to raise public awareness of Cambodian students. Other products will be sold through online promotions.

The third group (Afterglow) released a series of videos to raise fund. The videos explored the difficulties faced by Cambodian students in their daily lives, including the economy, environmental pollution, and public health, to raise Hong Kong people's awareness of the current situation in Cambodia and extend a helping hand. They will post the videos on various social media platforms to gain more support.

After deducting the costs, all the funds raised by the three groups will be donated to the Amity Foundation (Hong Kong) to assist in building libraries and water and electricity facilities for Cambodian village schools. We hope that all of you can support the fundraising activities of the three groups!

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### **Read To Inspire**

Last month, we were honoured to have Ms. Florence Lau, the founder and CEO of CantoGather, as the guest speaker of the 22nd regular webinar of Dream Compassioneers. She shared her service experience with us under the theme of "The Art Of Neighboring".

Ms. Lau and her team have founded CantoGather, a community that promotes Cantonese language and multicultural integration. They aim to establish a harmonious environment that embraces diversity through Cantonese and various cultures. Ms. Lau, driven by her Christian faith, decided to create this organisation to assist ethnic minority individuals who face difficulties integrating into Hong Kong's local Chinese culture due to language and cultural differences, causing challenges in education and employment.

Ms. Lau shared her organization's work, including volunteer recruitment and providing educational support to ethnic minority children. They also organise regular activities at primary schools, tailored to the Chinese proficiency levels of ethnic minority students, to teach them Chinese and explain the history of Chinese culture. Ms. Lau emphasised that their goal is not only to teach the Cantonese language but also to create a multicultural and inclusive environment that promotes mutual respect. As a result, the organisation frequently holds cultural exchange events to introduce traditional Chinese festivals and celebrations to the ethnic minority community and allows tutors to experience the unique characteristics of Southeast Asian traditions together.
