As mentioned before, the first group organized a materials collection project and they have donated the materials to the homeless through the NGO ImpactHK. The second group have designed a local day trip for the special education needs children, which allows them to have a deeper understanding towards Hong Kong culture and society, helping them to overcome obstacles and enhance their confidence. The third group provides emotional support activity for the local Junior High School through art activities and teaching the participants useful tips to relieve stress. They also cooperated with social workers to teach the participants how to treat their emotions correctly.
