Service Project with Wu Yee Sun College, CUHK

Earlier on, our members and students from Wu Yee Sun College, CUHK, had finalized their initial ideas of organizing service projects and decided on their service directions and targets, including ethnic minority children, street sleepers, and other disadvantaged groups.

One of the groups has already launched their project by setting up a good-collecting booth on the 21st, 23rd, 27th, 28th, and 30th of March, at the Gallery of WYS College. The project aimed to raise awareness and understanding of the local homeless issue among Hong Kong students and to help those in need. Required goods will be collected and they will donate them to a local charity, ImpactHK, which distributes them to the homeless in different districts in Hong Kong.

Other groups have also started to contact different service organizations and prepare their services. Let's support them together. We look forward to their service achievements!



Cambodia Online Voluntary Teaching Project



Dream Compassioneers will organize a 3-month Cambodia Online Teaching Project with New Future for Cambodia, an orphanage located in Cambodia. Representatives from Dream Compassioneers and the Orphanage have conducted a meeting to discuss the details of the coming Cambodia Online Teaching Project. Starting in May, local undergraduates will conduct online real-time lessons with Cambodia's students every week. Around 20 students will join the programme, enhancing their English oral proficiency. It is hoped that this project can improve Cambodia's students' education quality and hence give them a better future.
